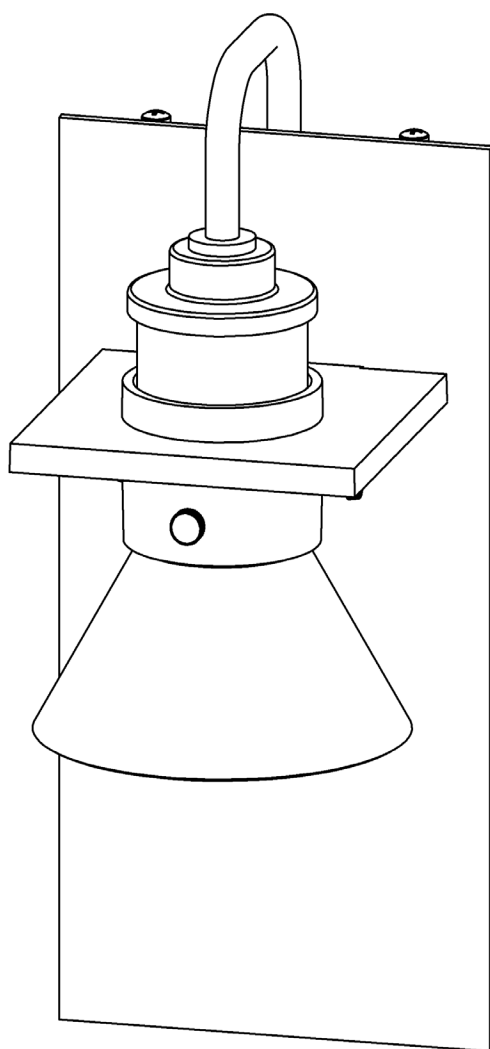

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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Component Parts

- A Fixture**
- B Mounting Bracket**
- C Anchors (4)**
- D #10 Screws (4)**
- E Ground Screw**
- F Cupped Washer**
- G Caulking Lip**
- H #8 Screws (4)**
- I Rubber Washer (2)**
- J Bulb (not included)**
- K Metal Shade**
- L Thumb Screw (3)**

Please Note: After installation extra hardware and accessories are possible; our kits are used on multiple products.

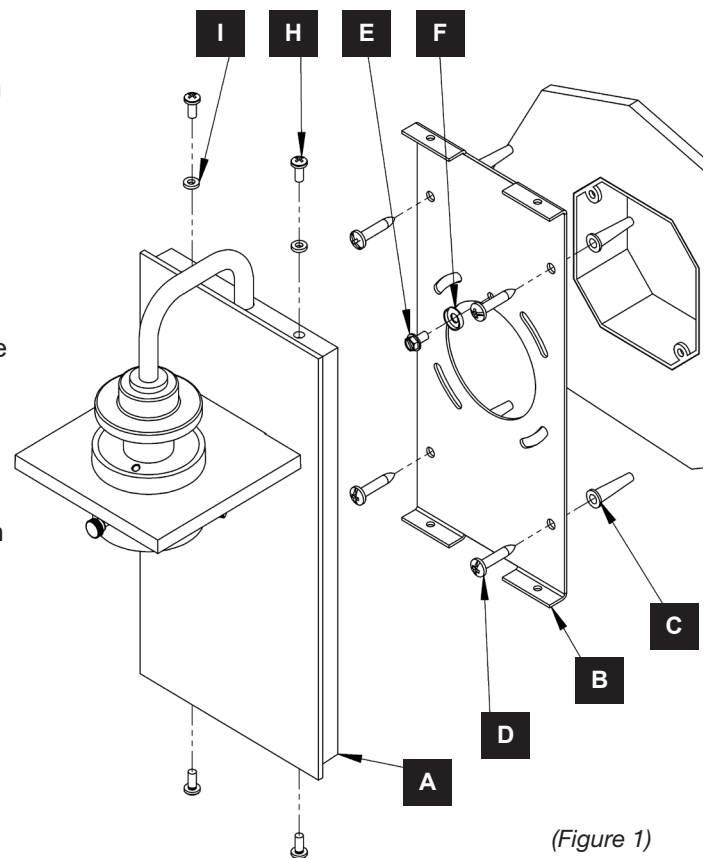
To Install Fixture (Figures 1 & 2)

CAUTION: BE SURE POWER IS OFF AT THE MAIN BREAKER BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

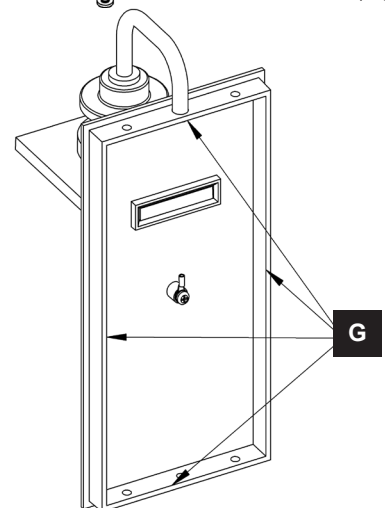
1. Carefully unpack the fixture (A) from the carton.
2. Take off rubber band and remove mounting bracket (B) from fixture (A).
3. Place the mounting bracket (B) over the electrical box being sure to hold it level. Line up holes in mounting bracket with holes in electrical box. With a pencil, mark the location of all mounting holes in the mounting bracket on the wall behind. Set bracket aside.
4. Drill 1/4" holes in the locations marked on the wall. Place the tapered end of the anchors (C) into the holes and gently tap them flush to the wall using a light weight hammer.
5. Thread the wires in the electrical box through the hole in the mounting bracket (B) while moving the bracket into position. Using (2) #8 machine screws (not provided), attach the crossbar securely to the junction box.
Note: A new electric box comes with screws. When replacing an existing fixture, retain screws for use with the new fixture
6. Using #10 screws (D), screw the bracket securely to the wall. Be careful not to over-tighten or strip the anchors (C).
7. Attach a pigtail lead to the mounting bracket (B) using the ground screw (E) and cupped washer (F) found in kit bag.
8. Hold fixture (A) close to wall. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided), connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to white and black to black). Connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green).

CAUTION: MAKE SURE WIRE CONNECTORS ARE TWISTED ON SECURELY, AND NO BARE WIRE IS EXPOSED.

9. Apply a generous bead of a suitable caulking material (not provided) to caulking lip (G) on the fixture (Figure 2).
10. Place fixture (A) over mounting bracket (B). Secure with #8 screws (H) and rubber washer (I) on top and #8 screws (H) bottom of fixture. Be sure no wires are pinched between fixture and wall.

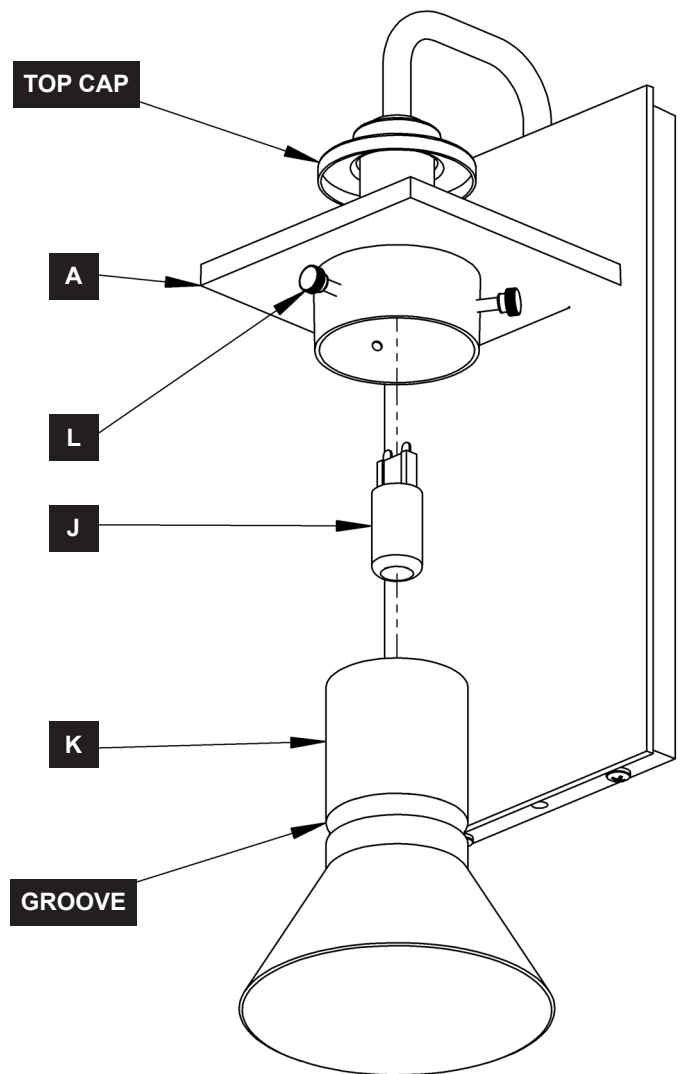

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To Install Metal Shade (Figure 3)

1. Locate and unpack metal shade (K)
2. Install Bulb (J) - (not included), into socket.
3. Remove the three thumb screws (L) and using the synthetic grease supplied apply to the threads of all screws. Note: Application of grease to the threads will need to be done each time the screws are unthreaded during bulb maintenance.
4. Thread thumb screws (L) back in fixture. Thread each one only a thread or two.
5. Raise metal shade (K) until groove is aligned with thumb screws (L). Top of metal shade (K) should be inside Top Cap as shown in Figure 3.
6. Tighten thumb screws (L) evenly until snug against metal shade (K).
7. Restore electricity at main breaker.
